
Prospect & Applicant User Guide

Prospects or Applicants: How to Access Admissions Application/Inquiry Portal?

- 1. Access the new B-CU Admissions Portal via B-CU official website through Admissions' page. Go to https://www.cookman.edu/index.html
- 2. Then click on the 'Admissions' Tab
- 3. Scroll to the middle of the page and click on 'Apply' button as seen on screenshot below .






First-Time on the Site? Create an Account

- If this is your first time on this site, you must create a account. You will do that in the following steps
- 1. Click the blue "New Applicant" hyperlink under password to create your account.



First-Time on the Site? Create an Account (Cont.)

- 2. Fill out the form with all required information. Make sure that email provided is a valid email. That email will be your username and will be used for all communications.
- 3. Click on 'Create Account'
- 4. A verification email will be sent to the email you provided here for authentication.
- 5. Go **check** your email and click on the authentication link that you see in the email notification that you have received from the system.



First-Time on the Site? Create an Account (Cont.)

- 6. Click on 'Back to Login' option to get back to the login window 7. Enter your authenticated login credentials to log into the portal




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Returning to the Site? Log Into the Portal


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Prospect or Applicant?

- **Prospect:** Select the appropriate Inquiry form :
 - Graduate Studies Inquiry Form
 - Undergraduate Study Inquiry Form
- Applicant:
 - New Applications: Make sure that you select the type of application that you want to submit.
 - Undergraduate
 - Graduate

Applicants: Select and Start Application

Make sure to select the correct application.

➤ UNDERGRADUATE


If you plan to do Undergraduate Studies to either get a degree (e.g., a Bachelor) or not, you 'Must' select an application under the Undergraduate Section

➢ GRADUATE

If you plan to do Graduate Studies to either get a degree (e.g., a Master) or not, you 'Must' select an application under the Graduate Section for the specific program that you are interested in


NOTE: All sections of the application must be completed before submission.

When to Submit Your Application?

NOTE: All sections of the application must be completed before you submit.



Applicant- Application Complete & Reviewing

The following criterion have to be met for a complete application to be ready for review.

A. <u>Undergraduate Application</u>

- 1. Application form submitted
- 2. Official Transcript
- 3. SAT or ACT Scores
- 4. TOEFL (International-Non English Speakers applicants)

B. **Graduate Application**

- 1. Application form submitted
- 2. Official College Transcripts
- 3. At least 2 Letters of Recommendation
- 4. GRE
- 5. TOEFL Score(International-Non English Speakers applicants)

Note: Log back into the portal any time to check the status of your Application. Look under 'Status' Tab.

Applicant- Final Decision and Offer

Final Admission Decision

After Admissions' Committees review the applications and provide their official recommendations, applicants receive their final decision electronically via the portal.


Therefore as an applicant, you should check your portal often to see your status.

Here is what happens:

- Once Final Decision is assigned, as applicant, you will have a new tab appearing in the portal called "Admissions Decision".
- When you select this tab, you will see the Final Decision.
 - 1. If you were **offered admissio**n, you will see under **Offer** subtab the **Offer Letter** for the specific program/location.
 - Go and click on the letter to see and read your Admissions Offer Letter.
 - 2. You will also have a **subta**b called "**Offer Response**" that you need to select & complete.
 - Once you select a decision (Accept or Decline), your application' status will automatically be updated in the portal. Admissions office
 will then see your offer response.
- If you were denied admission, you will also see the Deny tab with the denial letter.


Applicant's View: Final Decision and Offer
